

CRITERIA FOR AWARDING OF SCHOLARSHIPS

Minimum Criteria for the Awarding of Scholarships

- 1. A limited number of scholarships are awarded to new pupils only on acceptance to WBHS.
- 2. Meeting the criteria is no guarantee of a scholarship being awarded.
- 3. All applicants who meet the criteria will be ranked against one another in each category, and the available scholarships will be awarded to those in the top ranking.
- 4. The conduct and attitude of scholarship holders both in the classroom and towards co-curricular activities is expected to be exemplary. The behaviour, demeanour and attitude of those who receive scholarships shall at all times comply with the School's Code of Conduct.
- 5. The recipient retains his scholarship provided that he conducts himself in an exemplary manner and maintains, or enhances his level of commitment, expertise and involvement in the field for which the scholarship was awarded.
- 6. Recipients of scholarships are required to prioritise their obligations and commitments to the School. These obligations and commitments to the School will take precedence over responsibilities to out side clubs and organisations.
- 7. The following minimum criteria are used as a guideline for the awarding of scholarships at WBHS:

ACADEMIC SCHOLARSHIPS

Headmaster's/Major/ Half and Part Scholarships

Pupils who achieve 80% or more in English and Mathematics at their current school, and whose overall academic average exceeds 80% will be invited to write the **Academic Scholarship Exam at WBHS on Friday, 7th of May 2021.**

Following the results of the Grade 7 Scholarship Exam in Maths and English, a limited number of Academic Scholarships will be awarded.

SPORTS SCHOLARSHIPS

Scholarships are only offered for certain Major School Sports.

FULL SCHOLARSHIP (100% OF SCHOOL FEES)

An outstanding Sportsman in a chosen sport – Provincial Primary Schools 'A' team or an outstanding Sportsman who competes at District/Zonal level in at least 3 of the major school sports or the equivalent standard.

MAJOR SCHOLARSHIP (75% OF SCHOOL FEES)

An outstanding sportsman in one of the chosen major school sports – Provincial Primary Schools 'B' team or an outstanding Sportsman who competes at District/Zonal level in at least 2 of the major school sports or the equivalent standard.

HALF SCHOLARSHIP (50% OF SCHOOL FEES)

A sportsman who competes at District/Zonal level in 1 Major school sport and should play 'A' team in at least 3 major school sports.

PART SCHOLARSHIP (25% OF SCHOOL FEES)

A sportsman who plays 'A' team in at least 3 major school sports.

ALL-ROUND SCHOLARSHIPS

Headmaster's/Major/ Half and Part Scholarships

A pupil's academic, sporting and cultural value to the school will be taken into account.
