

# CRITERIA FOR AWARDING OF SCHOLARSHIPS

## MINIMUM CRITERIA FOR THE AWARDING OF SCHOLARSHIPS

1. A limited number of scholarships are awarded to new Applicants only on acceptance to WBHS.
2. Meeting the criteria is no guarantee of a scholarship being awarded.
3. All applicants who meet the criteria will be ranked against one another in each category, and the available scholarships will be awarded to those in the top ranking.
4. The conduct and attitude of scholarship holders both in the classroom and towards co-curricular activities is expected to be exemplary. The behavior and attitude of those who receive scholarships shall all times comply with the school's Code of Conduct.
5. The recipient retains his scholarship provided that he conducts himself in an exemplary manner and maintains or enhances his level of commitment, expertise and involvement in the field for which the scholarship was awarded.
6. Recipients of scholarships are required to prioritize their obligations and commitments to the school. These obligations and commitments to the school will take precedence over responsibilities to outside clubs and organizations.
7. The following minimum criteria are used as a guideline for the awarding of scholarships at WBHS:

## ACADEMIC SCHOLARSHIPS

### Full / Major / Half and Part Scholarships

Applicants who achieve 80% or more in English and Mathematics at their current school, and whose overall academic average exceeds 80%, will be invited to write the Academic Scholarship Exam at Westville Boys' High School on the first Friday of the second term. Following the results of the Grade 7 Scholarship Exam in Maths and English, a limited number of Academic Scholarships will be awarded. In recognition of the high standards we place on academics, the Governing Body and Senior Management have decided to implement a reward system for those boys who achieve the top 3 positions in each grade at the end of each academic year. This will be a % rebate on school fees offered to pupils in Gr 8 to Gr11. i.e. The student placed 1st at the end of the academic year will receive a 50% rebate, which will be credited against his school fee account, this is in addition to any Scholarship he may already have, not exceeding 100%. The 2nd place student will receive a rebate of 30% and the third a rebate of 20%

## SPORTS SCHOLARSHIPS

**Scholarships are only offered for certain major school sports**

### FULL SCHOLARSHIP (100% OF SCHOOL FEES)

An outstanding Sportsman in a chosen sport – Provincial Primary School's 'A' team, or an outstanding Sportsman who competes at a District/Zonal level in at least 3 of the major school sports or the equivalent standard.

### MAJOR SCHOLARSHIP (75% OF SCHOOL FEES)

An outstanding Sportsman in one of the chosen major school sports – Provincial Primary School's 'B' team, or an outstanding Sportsman who competes at District/Zonal level in at least 2 of the major school sports or the equivalent standard.

### HALF SCHOLARSHIP (50% OF SCHOOL FEES)

A sportsman who competes at District/Zonal level in 1 major school sport and should play 'A' team in at least 3 major school sports.

### PART SCHOLARSHIP (25% OF SCHOOL FEES)

A sportsman who plays 'A' team in at least 3 major school sports.

## ALL-ROUND SCHOLARSHIPS

### Full/Major/Half and Part Scholarships

A Applicant's academic, sporting and cultural value to the school will be taken into account.
