The BGA Hub at WBHS will serve as a stand-alone Academic Academy in a dedicated venue designed to meet learners' digital and academic needs. This model allows students to progress independently through the curriculum with Learning Coach support, while also enjoying full access to the school's sporting and cultural activities.

Our Curricula

US Curriculum (Accredited by NCAA) The American curriculum is offered through a partnership with the eCampus Academy and US University Pathways.

It allows our Learners to earn a US high school diploma and enrol in an American college or university.

British International Curriculum (Accredited by Pearson) This curriculum is grouped into the following levels: Year 7-9, International GCSE and AS-Levels.
